Lake Anna Chardonnay Barrel Select ~ Virginia ~

A delightfully balanced pairing of oak and chardonnay fruit. At home on the winter dining table or on the summertime deck. Ideal with creamy soups, pastas and heartier chicken dishes.

Lake Anna Lake Side Red ~ Virginia ~

Exotically perfumed, fruity red wine, sweet and enticing. A white wine's soul in a red wine's body. An excellent picnic wine and perfect with Thai cuisine or spicy dishes. Serve chilled or at room temperature.

Lake Anna Lake Side Sunset ~ Virginia

Sociable and fun, great for sipping or as an accompaniment with light conversation. A staple in the picnic basket that can be enjoyed with simple breads, cheese and everyday fare.

Lake Anna Lake Side White ~ Virginia

Dried peaches and vanilla with a touch of lime zest in a semi-dry complement to picnics, salads and pasta. Fermented and aged in stainless steel tanks. Whole cluster pressing of the red grape Muscat Hamburg adds to the exotic appeal.

Lake Anna Spotsylvania Claret ~ Virginia

A nose of chocolate-covered berries enhances this off-dry Italian style red.

Lake Anna Totally Red ~ Virginia

No red cherries, no spicy berries. No toasty nuances, no suggestive notes. Just merlot, cabernet franc, tannat, touriga and chambourcin blended in an all purpose red wine ready for the dinner table or picnic basket.

Lake Anna Totally White ~ Virginia ~ Bronze Medal – 2006 Governor's Cup

A blend of Chardonnay, Viognier and Seyval Blanc. No green apples. No ripe peaches. No tropical touches. No subtle hints.

Lake Anna Washington Merlot ~ Virginia

Fruity and full-bodied red wine aged in oak to give it complexity. The understated charm and well mannered tannins make it a natural companion for grilled and roasted beef, pork, lamb and a wide range of pasta dishes.
