Cooper Vineyards Chardonnay ~ Virginia ~

Chardonnay 2005 – Bronze – Atlantic Seaboard 2006; Bronze Tasters Guild 2006! – Immensely refreshing with a crisp, bright acidity, and hints of mineral on the finish. Our third 100% estate Chardonnay was fermented and aged in stainless steel. On the taste, this wine is clean, crisp with bright acidity and would pair well with seafood and light hors d'oeuvres.

Cooper Vineyards Noche Chocolate ~ Virginia ~

Chocolate wine? What's not to love? Known for ages as one of life's perfect pairings, Cooper Vineyards has brought red wine and chocolate together in an ice wine made from Norton Grapes infused with chocolate essence. Ice wine (a.k.a Icewine or Eiswein) is a sweet dessert-style wine made using grapes that are frozen before pressing. Much of the water content of the grape stays crystallized and does not press out. This process creates a juice for fermentation that has concentrated sugars and intense flavors. First made popular in Germany ice wine has also become widely produced in Canada and New York State. Cooper Vineyard's Noche Chocolate makes an excellent celebration wine, after dinner drink or night-cap. Packaged in a beautiful, sleek bottle, this unique wine makes the perfect gift for special occasions.

Cooper Vineyards Norton ~ Virginia ~

The 4th Vintage of their classic Virginia Norton with a new blend of 90% Norton and 10% Merlot. This Norton was sourced from 3 vineyards and aged in 100% Virginia oak for 15 months. With hints of vanilla oak and cherry on the nose this wine has a long luxurious finish.

Cooper Vineyards Rhapsody ~ Virginia ~

Cooper Vineyard's delightful sweet blend of Vidal Blanc, Chardonnay and Viognier with flavors of honeysuckle and melon. A "must have" for romantic weekend getaways and all festive occasions!! Pair with appetizers of cheese and fruit, grilled fish and roasted chicken. 100% Virginia sweet white table wine.

Cooper Vineyards Petit Verdot ~ Virginia ~

Petit Verdot won a Gold medal at the 2007 Virginia Governor's Cup. It is a blend of 80% Petit Verdot, 10% Merlot and 10% Cabernet Sauvignon. It has a full berry flavor and a slightly spicy, but smooth finish. Cheddar cheese is a perfect match.

Cooper Vineyards Sweet Louisa ~ Virginia ~

In a screwcap, this is a unique blend of Munsen, Norton, Concord, and Roussane grapes with 6% residual sugar. A delicious refrigerator red wine that also makes a great Sangria!

Cooper Vineyards Vida ~ Virginia ~

Vidal Blanc Ice Wine. Frozen grapes were gently pressed to produce an alluring flavor of nectar and apricot.
